(1) Application in Form XX prescribed under the said rules duly filled and signed. (2) DD for ₹ 500/- towards scrutiny fee, drawn in favour of Chief Controller of Explosives payable at Nagpur from any Nationalized/Scheduled bank. (3) Three copies of passport size photographs of the applicant. (4) Bio data including detailed professional experience. (5) Copy of document in support of identification proof. (6) Copy of documents in support of qualification & experience as prescribed below:-

Minimum experience of 10 years in testing and fabrication or mounting of petroleum transport tanks and operation and maintenance of petroleum tank vehicles.
