- 4. Security Deposit: On being intimated about the acceptance of the bid the tenderer shall pay a Security Deposit attherateof3% of the total value of purchase order being awarded. The Security Deposit amount to be deposited in the form of Account Payee Demand Draft, FD receipt, Bank Guarantee or NEFT/RTGS in favor of Central Medical Services Society within 5 days from the date of receipt of PO or can be deducted from running bills. 5. Transportation cost: to be paid at rates at approved rates @ Rs. 3.90/MT/KM.(destination/consignee distance from Manufacturing/dispatch site).

Note: Unloading cost of Medical oxygen cylinders shall be borne by the consignees.

- 6. Warranty: 1 year from the date of delivery.
- 7. Consignees are the Public Health Facilities and are located all over India(PAN India) details will be shared later, prior dispatch.
- 8. Liquidated Damages: The PESO clearance date and dispatch date(which is within 3 days of PESO clearance date) will be mentioned in Purchase Order. By these dates the committed qty. needs to get PESO clearance and further dispatched. Failure to get clearance by PESO and dispatch by these dates would attract the Liquidity damages @2.5% per week for delayed quantity in securing PESO clearance and dispatching by committed date/s, up to a maximum of 10% of P.O. Cost, irrespective of the fact that whether the consignee has suffered any damage/ loss or not, on account of delay in effecting supply.

Post PESO clearance, 3 days would be provided for dispatch to consignee locations. MoHFW would give a proper certificate declaring that these medical goods are ordered by GOI and essential medical supplies, soliciting support and cooperation of concerned authorities.

9. Allocation of quantity: The bidders are requested to quote their respective quantities of B Type & D Type Medical Oxygen Cylinders in accordance with their capacities ready for PESO clearance within the desired time frame as mentioned in Annexure-4. While distribution of the ordered qty, efforts would be made to align it in accordance with the MSME, DPIIT and MoF guidelines, however in view of the pandemic situation and purely in the interest of public health, Tender Inviting Authority reserves the right to suitably adopt the distribution aiming the situational urgency and with the approval of appropriate authority.

9.1 Micro and Small Enterprises as per classification given in MSME Notification dtd. 26.06.2020 registered under "Udyam Registration" w.e.f 01.07.2020 -In accordance to the Public Procurement Policy for Micro & Small Enterprises effective from 9th November 2018, the participating Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) in a tender, quoting price within the band of L 1 + 15% would be allowed to supply a portion of the requirement by bringing down their price to the L 1 price, in a situation where L 1 price is from someone other than an MSE.
